
# ANGER IS (ALMOST ALWAYS) BAD & UNHEALTHY

Christian men often try to justify their anger with excuses like "anger isn't always bad!" While that's true, it's imbalanced.

There are sixty verses in the New Testament that speak about anger. Let's take a look...



#### RIGHTEOUS HUMAN ANGER. ONE VERSE. - 1.7%

Ephesians 4:26 commands Christians to "Be angry and do not sin." There are times when Christ's followers are angry without sin.

A few thoughts here...

- 1. There's only one verse. Don't build your understanding of anger on this one verse, ignoring the other 59.
- 2. Righteous anger is concerned about the welfare of other people and the glory of God, not our own comfort. In your anger, are you loving God and loving others (righteous), or are you merely concerned about your own comfort (sinful)?
- 3. In the same paragraph, we are commanded to "Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice" (Eph 4:31).

Anger is usually sinful, so don't excuse it, put it away.
